Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 'Era', Organic,

Abruzzo, Italy

Deep red with an intense aroma of sour cherries; Medium bodied & savoury with soft tannins

Six Poets Cabernet Sauvignon, California, USA 2017

Delicious with all the precision and polish for which the style is famous. Packed with ripe blackcurrant and brambly forest fruits as well as a touch of earthy notes that

linger on the palate.

Los Medanos Malbec, Organic, Bodega Vinecol,

Mendoza, Argentina

Good structure, balanced with juicy plum, spice and hints of chocolate with a finish full of dark fruit.

Lucien Lardy, Beaujolais Villages "Vignes de 1951", Beaujolais, France

£6.50 £35.00

Bright red in colour with purple tints. The palate is bursting with crunchy summer fruit pudding fruit with some darker hedgerow blackberry notes. There is all fresh acidity you could wish for on the finish which is satisfying and surprisingly long. A wine that manages to be very

good fun and more serious than you expect.

Losada Mencia, Bierzo, Spain

Intensity and energy, with meaty, toasty and earthy notes framing black cherry, plum, liquorice and mineral

flavours. This wine beautifully demonstrates the potential of old vine Mencía.

Tenuta di Burchino Toscana, Italy

This wine has a characteristic bouquet with plenty of juicy cherry and berry flavours as well as an alluring balsamic

note on the finish.

Sumaridge Syrah, Overberg, £10.50£55.00

Western Cape, South Africa

Typically aromatic syrah leaning towards opulent spice and luscious black fruit with soft tannins and acid providing a balanced structure. Carefully judged new oak contributes to complexity whilst not masking the more

delicate aspects. Maturation - 18 months in small oak french barrels.

Château Jean Faux "Ste Radegonde", Biodynamic,

Bordeaux Superieur, France £12.00£60.00

Very intense on the nose with elegant red fruit, clove and some leather with elegant hints of the oak ageing. Lots of freshness and elegance. Red fruits, lighter dark fruits, some sweet spice and little owery notes from the Cabernet

Franc. An elegant and long lasting finish.

St Joseph 'Poivre et Sol', Francois Villard, Rhone Valley,

Interesting nose of spice and black fruit. Thee palate bears

open brambly fruits with a note of oak; has an elegant finish of smoky currants.

Nuits-Saint-Georges, Nicolas Potel, Burgundy, France

A vineyard with serious heritage where the first vines date back to 1896. Powerful aromas of plums and ripe black fruit with layered berry fruit and spicy intensity. Medium acidity and great complexity.
